I am pleased to say that the band has played at a number of engagements already this year, with the Queen's Platinum Jubilee weekend being particularly busy for

The Band played at Milton Lilbourne Earlier as residents celebrated the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. As part of the event, the highlight was the lighting of the beacon at Martinshell Hill, one of many across the country being lit to acknowledge Queen Elizabeth II's 70 years on the throne which gives her the accolade of the longest reign of any British monarch. Later in the evening the HM Lord-Lieutenant of Wiltshire, Mrs Sarah Rose Troughton, attended the event and addressed the crowds before the Platinum Jubilee Proclamation was made.

The Band opened the Froxfield Beer and Music Festival in their home village and played "Fanfare" to dedicate a Lime Tree that the Parish Council had planted on the village green as part of The Queen's Green Canopy, a unique tree planting initiative created to mark Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee in 2022 which invites people from across the United Kingdom to "Plant a Tree for the Jubilee".


